- Because in most of the time, my parents will take care of themselves/my siblings, but I did learn from them.



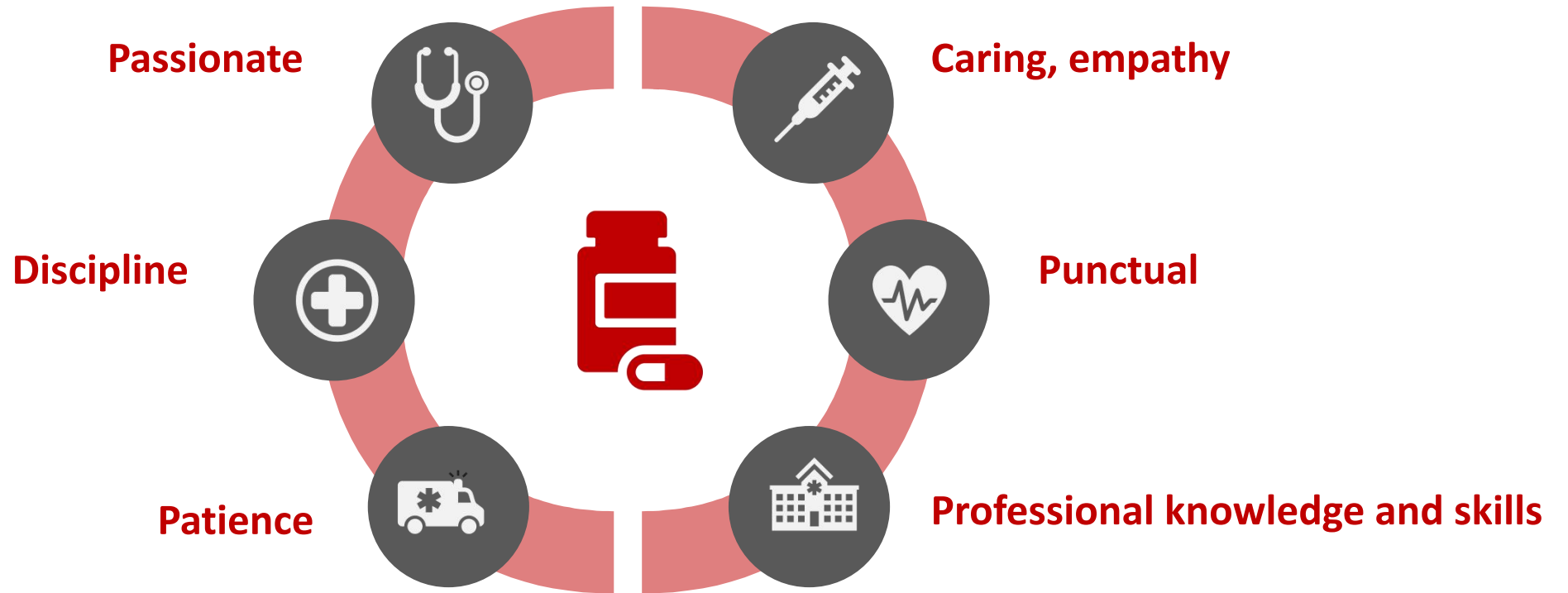

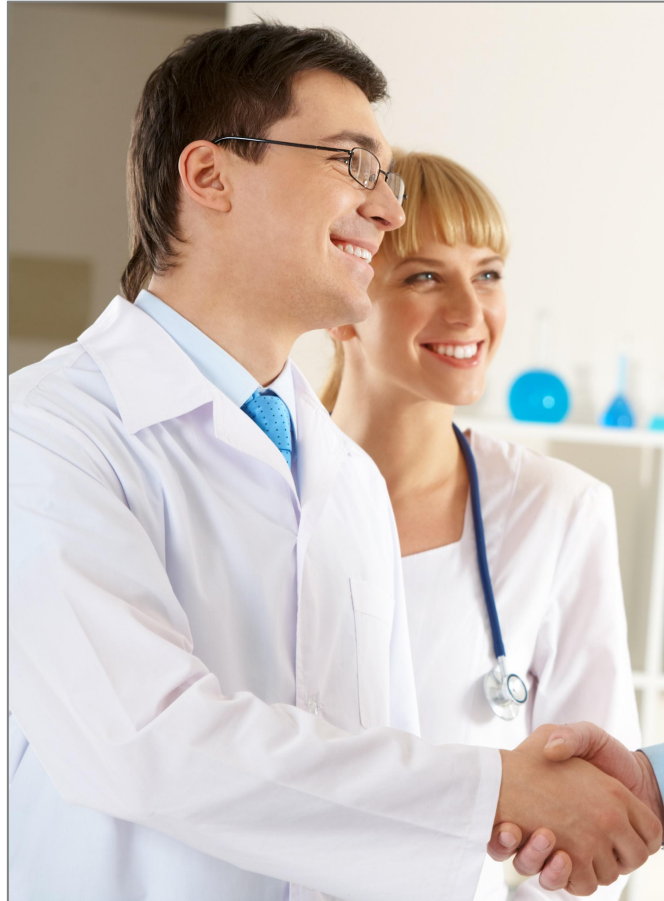


Do's and Don'ts
